VenuesWest is a Perth based organisation that owns 13 venues and manages seven of these on behalf of the Western Australia State Government, including RAC Arena and Optus Stadium. Hosting close to 2,000 events and welcoming over five million patrons last financial year, VenuesWest focuses on ensuring world class experiences for customers, partners, athletes and performers.

High performance sports demand high performance security

“Securing world class sporting and entertainment events is challenging in a competitive marketplace and even more so for the world’s most isolated capital city which needs to overcome the cost of touring and presenting live productions. VenuesWest increasingly requires world class technology solutions to match patron expectations, to meet employee needs, deliver operational efficiencies as well as value for money, and support the rapid innovation required to remain competitive.

As such, VenuesWest is undergoing a three-year digital transformation designed to improve user and customer experience; underpin better decision making through accurate data; enhance the security of the organisation; and ensure engagement with VenuesWest audiences.

Key to this is having the right foundation to enable digital transformation while ensuring operational security and establishing a safe environment for executives, employees, and partners.

VenuesWest chose Insight, as their strategic technology partner, to transition from on-premise infrastructure to Microsoft Azure cloud and embrace a secure mobile-first approach to technology, stripping friction from VenuesWest's IT team.

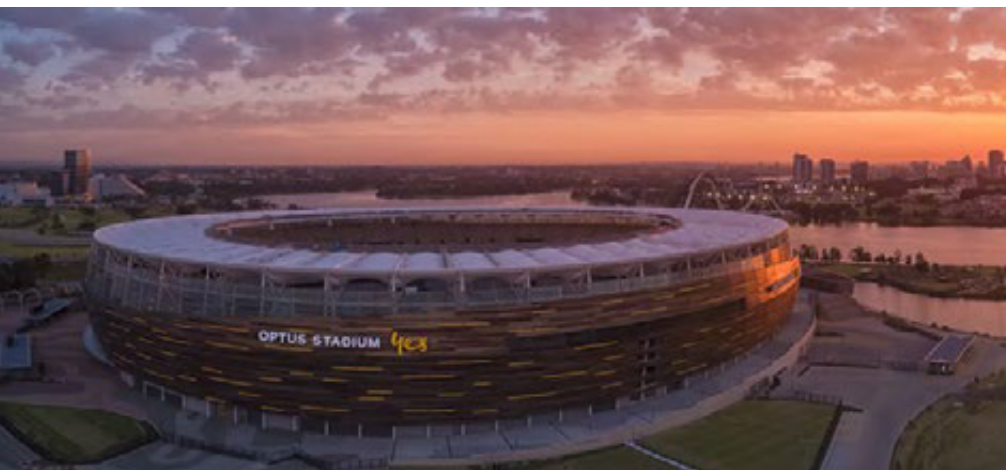


Championing digital transformation dreams

Business drivers for VenuesWest:

VenuesWest's digital transformation is aligned to the WA Government ICT strategy for cloud adoption, as well as driven by a number of factors including the phishing and social engineering attempts experienced by the organisation in recent times.

Embracing leading edge cloud and security technologies keeps VenuesWest on the front line in a fiercely competitive sector.

By transitioning workloads out of its on-premise data centre to Microsoft Azure, VenuesWest can rely on a high performing, resilient, secure and trusted infrastructure that can be accessed anytime, anywhere.

Windows 10 devices and Microsoft 365, with built-in security, provides flexibility without operational compromise to executives and employees, while Azure Active Directory manages access, to ensure integrity.

Identity-based protection:

- Secure single sign-on and self-service identity management capabilities for 1000's of cloud and on-premises apps with a single identity managed and protected
- Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) for user sign-ins and transactions to add an additional security layer
- Secure remote access for on-premises apps without using a virtual private network (VPN)
- Identity protection with machine learning-based threat detection and calculations of risk severity for every user and sign-in attempt
- Risk-based conditional access through an intelligent assessment of granting or blocking access and automatic protection from future threats
- Discovery and restriction of privileged identities and their access to resources (i.e. time limited "Just in Time" admin access) with Privileged Identity Management

VenuesWest tracks security progress using Office 365 Secure Score and Azure Security Centre:

- Achieved Office 365 secure score of 320 - almost 5 times the average score for government tenants
- Achieved Windows secure score of 450 - 3 times the average score for government tenants
- Achieved Identity secure score of 110 - 3 times the average score for government tenants

Improved security posture by re-thinking and modernising ICT architecture with Azure.

VenuesWest has deployed Advanced Threat Protection along with 'self service' password reset through Azure Active Directory. Multifactor authentication through Azure Active Directory is now also managing access to other cloud-based applications and ensuring group-wide security while reducing operational friction.

The focus on world-class security has seen the deployment of Windows Defender on servers and roll out of Windows 10. VenuesWest has reset passwords in line with NIST (National Institute of Standards and Technology) recommendations for 16 characters, and has deployed Azure Key Vault.

Focus on what's important

"If we need to move faster, then we need to embrace automation and because we're so small, not only do we need to embrace automation, but we also need to be smart about where we spend our resources.

I can say to executives and employees: 'Okay, we've got all these botnets. We've got all these command and control servers trying to access our services.' That's a very visual thing for them so they can understand. They can see that in the last 30 days, we've had 11,000 botnets trying to access our email servers and our HR system. That really brings home the importance of cybersecurity."

"Rather than moving to an operating platform or architecture and then needing to consider the cybersecurity approach, it is really embedded within the Microsoft cloud. So really, you get that protection and benefits as part of your overall learning platform. It sits very much meshed in and part of the ICT architecture which, in my view, is the best place for it to be."

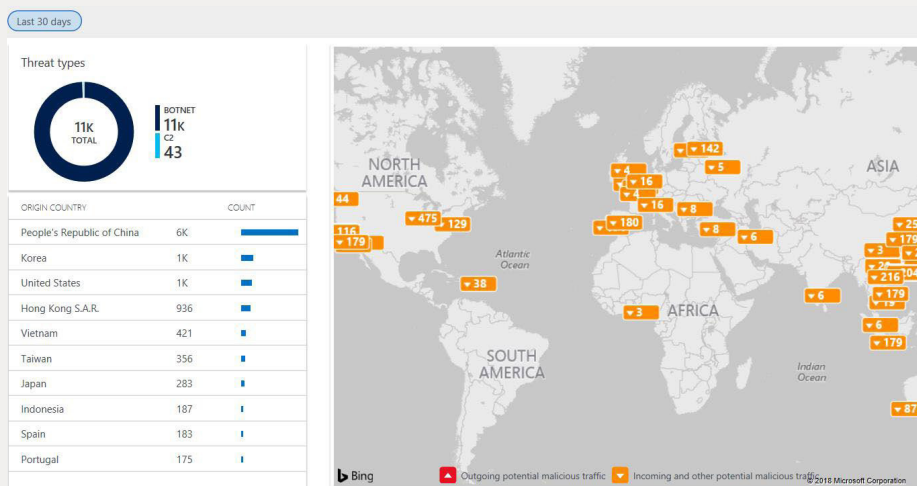


Figure 1. DNS Analytics from the Azure Portal (presented at the Oct. 2018 CIO Forum.)

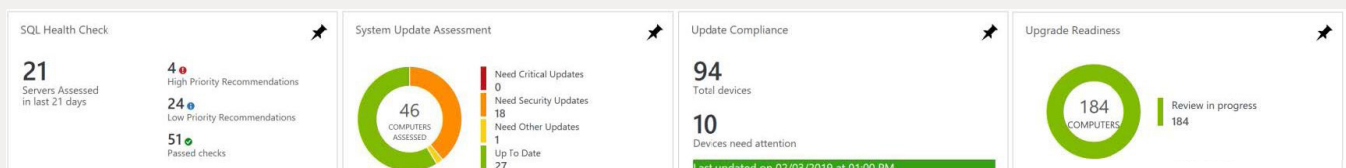


Figure 2. On-premises servers and PCs being monitored and controlled in Azure for VenuesWest.

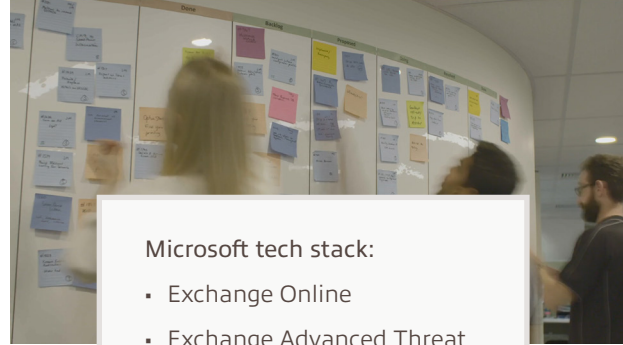
